Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 6450(c)(3), individuals with a baccalaureate degree or an advanced degree in any subject must also have completed a minimum of one year of law-related experience under the supervision of an attorney who has been an active member of the State Bar of California for at least the preceding three years or who has practiced in the Federal courts of this state for at least the preceding three years, and obtain a written declaration from this attorney stating that they are qualified to perform paralegal tasks before using the title "Paralegal."

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 6450(c)(4), individuals with a high school diploma or general equivalency diploma must also have completed a minimum of three years of law-related experience under the supervision of an attorney who has been an active member of the State Bar of California for at least the preceding three years or who has practiced in the Federal courts of this state for at least the preceding three years, and obtain a written declaration from this attorney stating that the person is qualified to perform paralegal tasks. This experience and training shall be completed no later than December 31, 2003.
